MESSENGER Being a Sender - A Gift of Presence BY KATE ULRICH

Seem like a stretch, but this is how the journey began for a Sender fondly known as "Padre" in the SAMS community. It all started with a gift in 2017 designated "Where Needed Most." Prayerfully, much needed funds were provided for SAMS Missionary April Sylvester. Padre received thanks and ongoing communication from April. April had recently co-founded the YANA (You Are Not Alone) Foundation in Ndola, Zambia, a ministry to young people with mental illness in a place where the closest psychologist is 6 hours away. Padre happens to be a retired priest and therapist in Texas.

Padre began checking in on April via email and praying for her. April responded, finding a true friend. God began to establish a warm mentoring relationship that

would transform the ministry perspective of both the missionary and her new Sender. Padre's perspective on mental health ministry significantly shaped April's ministry. His ways of living life with compassion made it into the training curriculum for YANA volunteers, who are called "Listeners." April received an image from Padre depicting the experience of a clinically depressed person sitting deep inside a dark cave. People at the mouth of the cave are calling them out, but one person enters the cave, sits down with them and says, "It's dark in here, isn't it?" In Padre's words, "The greatest gift we can give is to be present to people." April has used this image extensively to help Listeners understand how to minister to people struggling with mental illness. Jesus fully entered our brokenness as a human, and similarly Listeners provide friendship and support to hurting people that have nowhere else to turn.

The heart-felt sending relationship between Padre and April confers mutual blessing. Padre gives her the credit: "April was the genesis of my larger ministry to missionaries. I was connected financially, but not involved. Everything changed with April. I realized I need to do more than send a check." He has begun a new coaching ministry for missionaries, which included being the speaker at the 2019 SAMS Missionary Retreat in South Africa. Padre has written down his personal mission: "To purposefully live in the Sacrament of the Present Moment, touching the lives of others with the presence of God, bringing joy, healing and peace." As Senders, may we "be present" to our Missionaries in whatever way possible, beginning with prayer.

Serving as Senders

Sending Community Empowers Youth in Uganda BY KATE ULRICH

The saying goes that "no man is an island," and this is especially true of missionaries. SAMS Missionary Bridger Patrick Lutalo has a team of people behind him, championing his mission. His community at Christ Church in Colorado has supported him since September 2016 in the establishment of *Teach Men to Fish* in Uganda which provides youth with vocational skills while discipling them in Christ.

Patrick observed that many teenagers in Mityana, Uganda, are vulnerable and, in desperation, often become ensnared by crime, drugs, and prostitution. He responded by forming a ministry employing his extensive experience in construction to equip others. The apprentices are currently constructing a new maternity facility for the local community. Patrick recently updated his Senders: "As we give the apprentices skills, they are also giving back to their own community to show how God's love and compassion can be shared with others."

Patrick's community at Christ Church has played a vital role in getting the mission off the ground. A core group of 12-18 men, who meet weekly for Bible study at 6:30 a.m. led an initiative among all the men of the church to raise \$5,000 for a concrete mixer and brick

maker. The apprentices are using this equipment to construct the maternity facility. Sender Cynthia McRae, also of Christ Church, shares her joy: "I am committed to this ministry because I have a sense of the deep needs of folks there. Patrick is

providing an education and skills-training to young people who have had little [or] no opportunity to learn a trade, to provide hope or a future for themselves and their families. I admire him enormously and am very privileged to assist [Patrick] in any way I can." God is working through Patrick and his Senders to help young people build buildings and build up their lives in Christ. Patrick shares that the ultimate goal for the youth in their community is to "build His kingdom."



The Men's Bible Study raised \$5,000 for the brick maker and cement mixer, supporting the mission to equip young people practicallly and spiritually.
