Dear Mission Partners,

I have spent the last two weeks at my casita in San Lorenzo. We are having nine nights of posadas at different houses each night. The posada was at my casita on Monday. The villagers come down the road singing, led by two children dressed as Mary and Joseph. They knock on the door and sing to gain admittance, which they are denied until Christmas Eve, when they are finally recognized, invited in, and treated to a party.

The Episcopal clergy of the deanery came to San Lorenzo to celebrate Holy Eucharist this week. Over 70 people attended. Their visit also included two piñatas for the children. My casita has apparently become a tourist attraction, as all came to see it.

We have had a number of medical crises. For example, this week Don Leonardo, 95, became gravely ill, but after Rev. Victor prayed over him, he recovered quickly. Henry had to have an emergency appendectomy, but we expect a complete recovery because we prayed over him, too. Hilda, my Goddaughter has been healed through prayer as well and is walking without her ankle brace. We have many reasons to feel grateful.

I wish you all the love, joy, and peace that I feel this Christmas, as we get ready to commemorate the birth of the Holy Child.
