Dear Mission Partners,

School started this month, and we started with forty-six scholarships, thanks to you. We have 31 grade schoolers in San Lorenzo who have received uniforms, school supplies, breakfast, and lunch. There are 12 middle and high schoolers who are on scholarship, and two students who are on university scholarships. In addition we have one student on scholarship to bilingual school at St. Mary's Episcopal School in Tegucigalpa.

You are making a difference, one family at a time.

Normally the elementary students in San Lorenzo drop out in second or third grade to work in the fields, and we have never had twelve continue on to middle school or high school.

Since the program has started in San Lorenzo, no one has dropped out of elementary school. Attendance, thanks to the food, is almost perfect. One student at University is studying business administration, and one is studying tourism.

Our student at St. Mary's is on the honor roll. All our scholarship students must keep their grades up or forfeit their scholarship.

We have been blessed with two teams here this month, the Christian Veterinary Mission team to Valle de Jamastran, and a Daughters of the King team to the Daughters in the deanery of Danli.

It has been a month of blessings. I'm praising God and all the people whose hearts He's touched.

IN SAN LORENZO

- ALL FARMERS HARVESTED THIS YEAR. MANY HARVESTED ENOUGH TO TAKE THEM THROUGH TO THE HARVEST NEXT YEAR, FOR THE FIRST TIME IN SEVEN YEARS.
- WORK HAS STARTED ON THE CHURCH LOT. THE SCHOLARSHIP STUDENTS CLEARED THE LOT, THE MUNICIPALITY BULL-DOZED A ROAD TO IT, AND A CREW OF PROFESSIONALS AND VOLUNTEERS HAVE BEEN WORKING ON THE FENCE.
- WE APPLIED TO THE MUNICIPALITY FOR HELP WITH THE MATERIALS TO BUILD THE KINDERGARTEN. THE CITY HAS PLEDGED \$4220, APPROXIMATELY ONE-THIRD OF THE COST. WE ALSO HAVE AN APPLICATION IN FOR A HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE TO BE PAID TO TEACH KINDERGARTEN THIS YEAR.
