Dear Mission Partners.

Before Christmas the slaughter house gave us permission to haul manure for the compost pile. The rainy season is supposedly over. We've been waiting for this because it's much nicer to put dry manure in burlap bags and load them than it is to put wet manure in burlap bags. There's a roof to keep the manure nice and dry. So we went, but the manure was so wet that it took the shape of the sack. Somehow my workers had gotten all these kids to volunteer to come, so we had eight helping to bag and haul. I think the kids volunteered because they wanted to ride in the back of the pick-up -- that's a big deal for kids who never get to ride in a car -- and maybe for the possibility of some Coca Cola.

After the first trip I gave them coffee and rosquillas. After the second trip, my driver, Hector Jose, got them chips and Coca Cola. After the third trip, they got chop suey and fried rice, with tortillas and Coca Cola. There was tons of food and Hector Jose kept dishing it out until it was all gone. This is a big deal for poor farm kids whose mom divides the food for the family onto plates and there are no seconds for anybody.

After the fourth trip they went to the river to wash the manure-soaked bags and my pick-up. They loved the river - they washed themselves with their manure soaked clothes on, as well as the bags. They said that today was the most fun they have had for the entire Christmas vacation. They are really going to be sad when I start driving myself again and Hector Jose stays home.
