Jack Melvin with a SAMS World Relief Fund grant hired a Honduran pastor, who is also a professional mason, to construct a house for the Guerra family, who lost their home in the 2020 hurricanes. Jack, in addition to being the diocesan architect, also coordinates sponsors to support the education of at-risk children. The construction manager of the Guerra home project, Ana, graduated recently from university with help from this ministry Jack founded.




Total Giving: \$2,533,037
