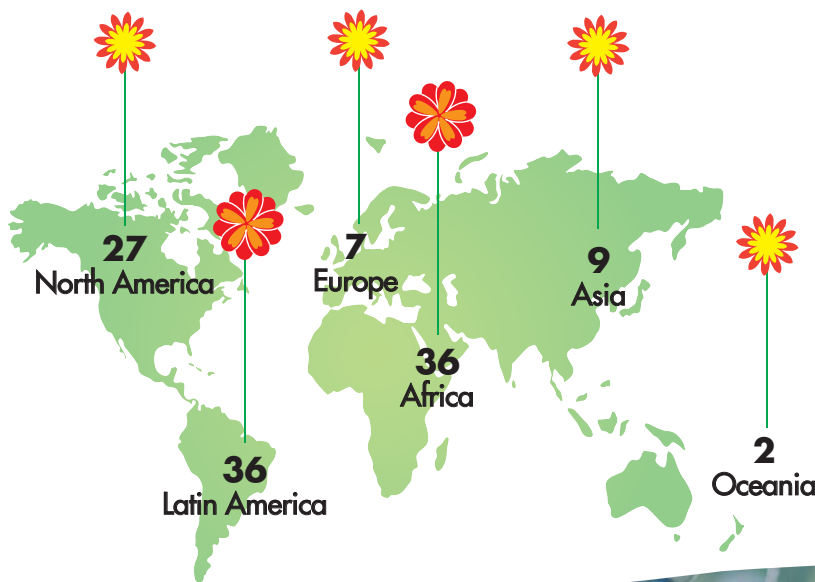

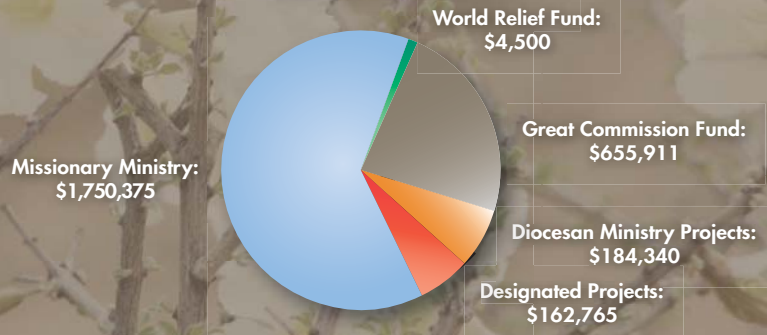
*Total Giving: \$2,867,160
