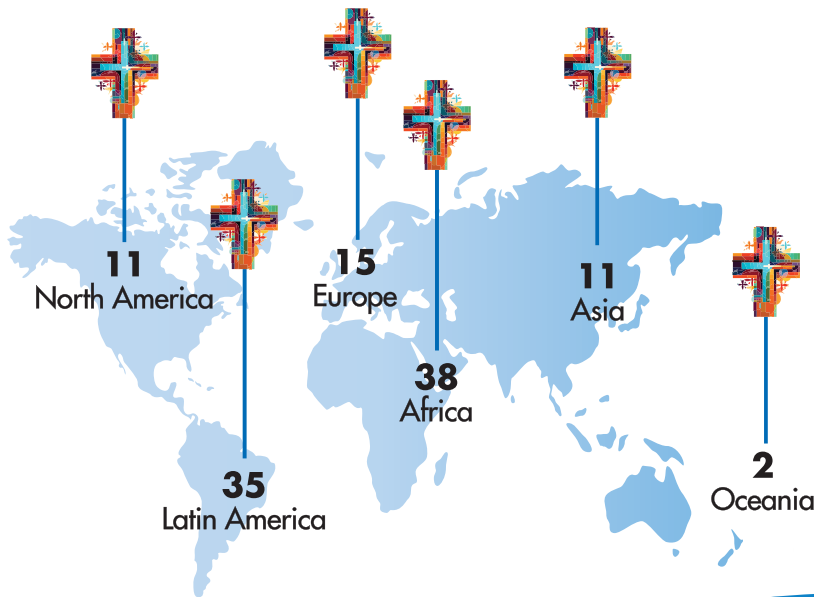




Making the Living God Known Among the Nations

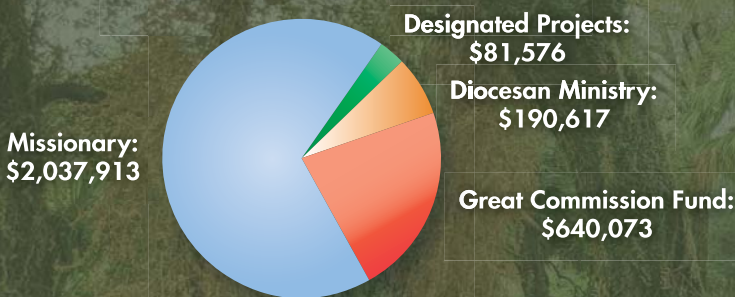

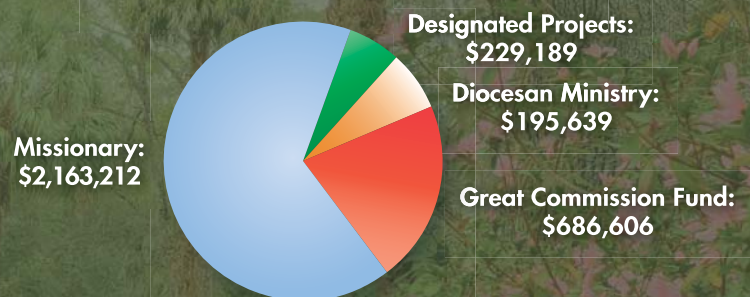
Total Giving: \$2,950,179*
